Weed control in irrigated crops will be featured Thursday, June 21 from 8:30 to 12:00 pm at the Panhandle Research and Extension Center, which is located just north of Scottsbluff on Highway 71.

Visitors will get the opportunity to view research plots in a variety of crops including: alfalfa, sugarbeets, corn, and dry beans. Weed control programs for RR corn, Liberty-Link corn, conventional corn, RR sugarbeet, and RR alfalfa will be shown on the tour.
